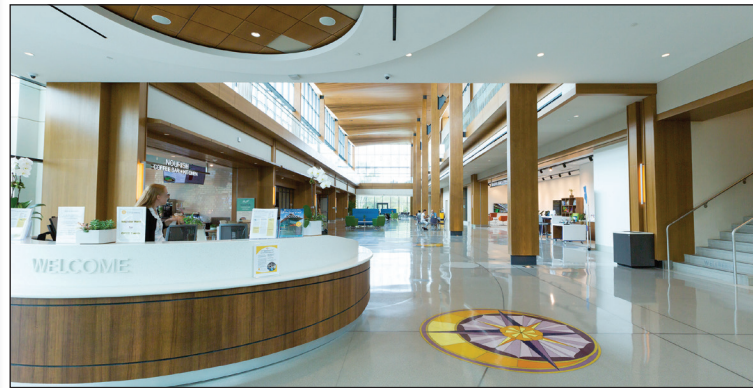

This new six-story facility offers state-of-the-art teaching spaces, with a sophisticated, classic design. The terrazzo accommodates a radiant heating system. The simple palette helps define zones and provides directional cues while harmonizing with other finishes. The 14-inch lighted cove base in the main corridor is precast, as well as the stairwell, wall-panel, and seating. Stainless steel accent planks in a dynamic pattern give a sense of movement throughout the lobby. The floor was finished to 2,000 grit to ensure a consistent finish with the planks.

THE CENTER FOR HEALTH AND WELLBEING WINTER PARK, FL



This health center integrates the realms of fitness, medicine, and wellness. This installation demonstrates the versatility of epoxy terrazzo as an artistic medium, with six medallions in 30 colors, set to advantage against a muted floor and rich woodwork. Intricate strip work went into the medallions, which take inspiration from the Seven Dimensions of Wellness and are both striking art pieces and symbols to orient visitors and reinforce branding. Black PVC divider strips provide maximum contrast between the vibrant resin colors. The steps incorporating metal inlay lettering consist of two-piece precast terrazzo.

Most of the flooring at this National Historic Site is original terrazzo, but some of the 1936 floor inlays are no longer accessible to visitors. During 2018 renovations to the 1995 Visitor Center, four of artist Alan Tupper True's intricate Art Deco designs were recreated in the public areas. Inspired by Southwest Native American design and elements of hydroelectric power, the inlays were precision waterjet-cut and hand troweled into place. The epoxy terrazzo installation includes a poured-in-place spiral staircase with a waterfall edge to ensure ease of maintenance.

LADUE HORTON WATKINS HIGH SCHOOL LADUE, MO



The renovation and expansion of this 64-year-old school showcases a classic yet engaging design and tasteful use of school colors and logo. The facility provides open spaces with ample room for group collaboration. The focal point of the main lobby area is amphitheater-style seating with benches of poured-in-place terrazzo, inlaid maple seats, and precast terrazzo steps. Terrazzo in a four-color design continues throughout the new addition in the art room, commons area, hallways and cafeteria with a four-inch precast wall base.

This gorgeous renovation of a historic bank into a new, modern hotel in Nashville's art district received a 2019 Historic Preservation Award from the Metro Nashville Historic Commission. Impressive craftsmanship is evident, particularly on the poured-in-place vertical work on the bar front and the luxurious floor-to-ceiling terrazzo in the restrooms. The divider strips, all hand bent onsite, enhance the retro tones and patterns of the lobby and café. The three-color epoxy terrazzo floor unifies the aesthetic of the lobby, with its brass feature wall and original oak paneling, while adding value as a low-maintenance, durable floor.

SANFILIPPO PERFUME PASSAGE MUSEUM SOUTH BARRINGTON, IL



The installation of this museum-quality floor in a private museum dedicated to the artistry of perfume bottles and related items was the architect's first project using terrazzo. The sophisticated design of curves lines up with millwork and responds to lighting and mechanical requirements. Installers produced over 100 samples to bring the design in six colors to life. All dimensions were calculated with CAD; field measurements were placed into a shop drawing and then transferred by hand to the floor. All divider strips were hand bent following radius templates.

This welcoming space is in a brand-new LEED-certified hospital. The warm, neutral color scheme of the terrazzo floor plays its role to perfection in the Mediterranean-inspired design of the five-story facility. The floor harmonizes beautifully with the bronze and warm cherry wood, all contributing to a bright and calming environment for visitors and patients. The precise divider strip pattern aligns up in the corridor to appear uniform between non-uniform columns. Extensive critical lighting showcases the flatness of this high-polish, easy-maintenance floor.

CHAFFEY HIGH SCHOOL - GARDINER W. SPRING AUDITORIUM ONTARIO, CA



This auditorium was a state-of-the-art facility when it opened in 1939. When renovations began in 2017, the intricate terrazzo patterns proposed by the architects provided the perfect opportunity to showcase the contractor's skills, as well as terrazzo's design capacity and durability. A wide array of aggregates and colors were sourced to provide a period-accurate design to complement the architecture. Lacking as-built drawings of the historic structure for the design work, installers relied on state-of-the-art 3-D laser scanning to capture accurate dimensions. Excellent craftsmanship is evident throughout this installation.

BANK OF AMERICA TOWER

HOUSTON, TX



Traditional sand-cushion cement terrazzo is installed in the basement of this new skyscraper, where a 35,000 square-foot hub, The Understory, encompasses a market, bar, restaurant, and tunnels connecting to the buildings across the street. Monolithic Venetian terrazzo, the focal point of all interior finishes, was specified as the common denominator to coordinate the aesthetic of the classically simple multi-use space. The larger Venetian aggregate and hand-crafted heavy-top divider strip beautifully complement the scale and elegance of the site. The community area in the 35-story office tower includes fitness and activity centers and art installations. The terrazzo on the floors, ramps, and stairs is all poured-in-place. The installation demonstrates outstanding craftsmanship, from the execution on the tread and risers and the skill that went into grinding, particularly on the large chips on the edge of the ramps, to the perfect flatness of vertical surfaces and consistent aggregate density on all surfaces. The tower is the first LEED v4 Platinum Core & Shell certified project in the nation.

The goal of this renovation was to create a timeless yet upscale aesthetic to last the life of the building while honoring the heritage of the 1923 facility. It is one of only four historic athletic stadiums in the United States and is a designated National Historic Landmark. Exemplary work on vertical terrazzo distinguishes this meticulously executed project. The installation of epoxy thin-set terrazzo in seven colors included a new tower, suites, restrooms, press boxes, lobbies, lounges, concessions, and six elevator cabs across seven stories, all achieved within the constraints of a historic renovation.

WALNUT GROVE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL BARGERSVILLE, IN



This floor combines the toughness of terrazzo with seven bright, charmingly cheerful colors that will last for the life of this new school. The school district had used classic-style terrazzo flooring in most of their schools previously and with this project chose to give designers a freer creative license. The floor's engaging design aids in directional way finding and interacts well with the architectural space and with the adjacent floor finishes; note the match of the carpet accent color and that of the terrazzo.

This stylish, concept-driven interior of a new café is inspired by the narrative of Depression glass knives. The star pattern and colors of the custom terrazzo floor reflect the detailing commonly found on the handles of these knives, and each star is embedded with chips of crushed glass knives that belonged to the cafe owner's mother. Black plastic divider strips provide high contrast with the bright epoxy resin colors. The crisp, eye-catching design is complemented with brass, which is also incorporated into the black stars with brass shavings.

HUDSON SQUARE LOBBY NEW YORK, NY



The transformation of an old industrial site into a multi-use facility was accomplished using large-aggregate Palladiana and Venetian terrazzo with inlaid brass accents. The textured curves of the platform, benches, planters, and steps carve out a productive meeting space within lobby circulation, lending value to the property. Stair nosings render the appearance of a two-inch-thick slab, though the innovative design is achieved with a three-eighths-inch thin-set epoxy terrazzo system. The hand-broken marble was fractured, mounted, and installed offsite in numbered sheets, and reassembled onsite like pieces of a puzzle. The entire floor was ground and polished like a monolithic system.

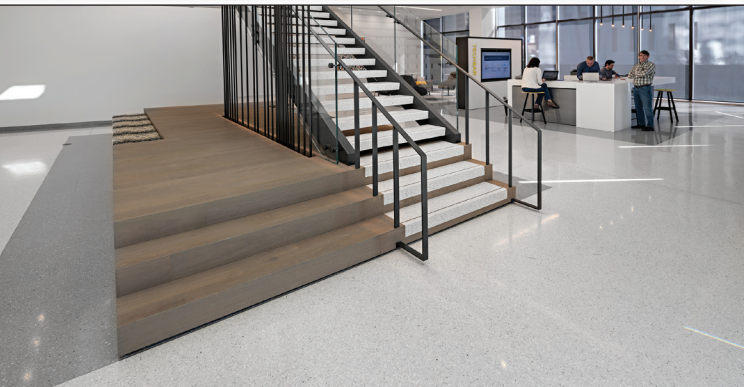
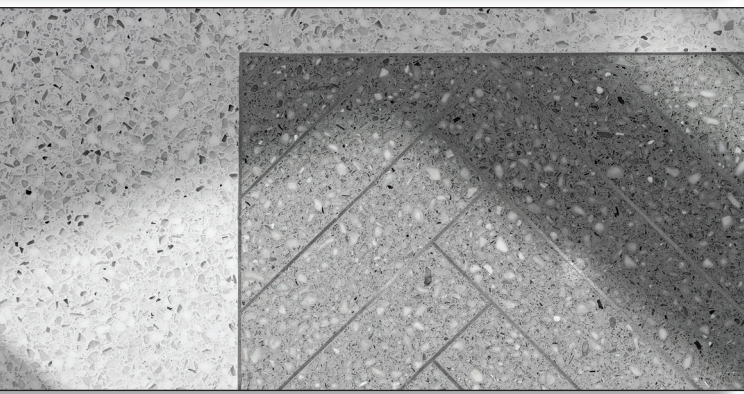

This new, LEED Gold certified, 20-story tower is one of the largest built in the city's downtown in recent years and serves as a high-performance workplace for over 1,000 employees. The crisp, clean installation of epoxy terrazzo consists of three colors with a mixture of marble, glass, and mother-of-pearl aggregate. Terrazzo color blocking accents architectural elements in the minimalistic, modern design. Spaces are subtly defined with lighting and terrazzo accent borders, radius patterns, divider strip accents, a handsome waterjet-cut herringbone strip pattern, and monumental precast stair.

1271 AVENUE OF THE AMERICAS NEW YORK, NY



This iconic lobby is a designated New York City landmark. A masterpiece of mid-century modernism, it opened in 1959, and was designed by Rockefeller Center architect Michael Harris. The iconic Eames Time-Life chairs were created for this classic interior. During renovations, the original Venetian sand-cushion terrazzo floor was removed and a duplicate new floor was installed. Plywood templates were made to recreate the serpentine design, inspired by the sidewalks of Rio de Janeiro's Copacabana Beach. The terrazzo design continues from the main lobby into the elevators.

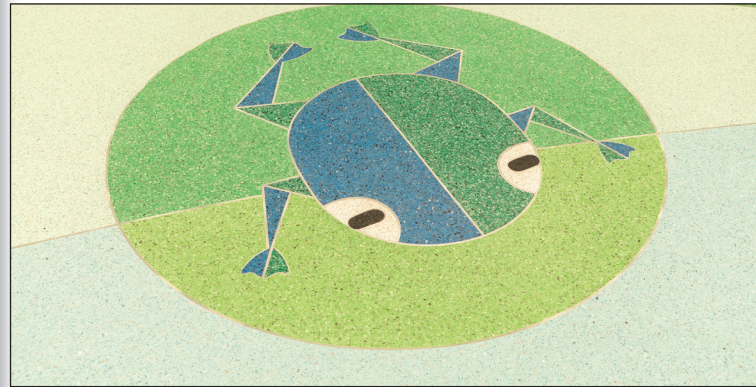
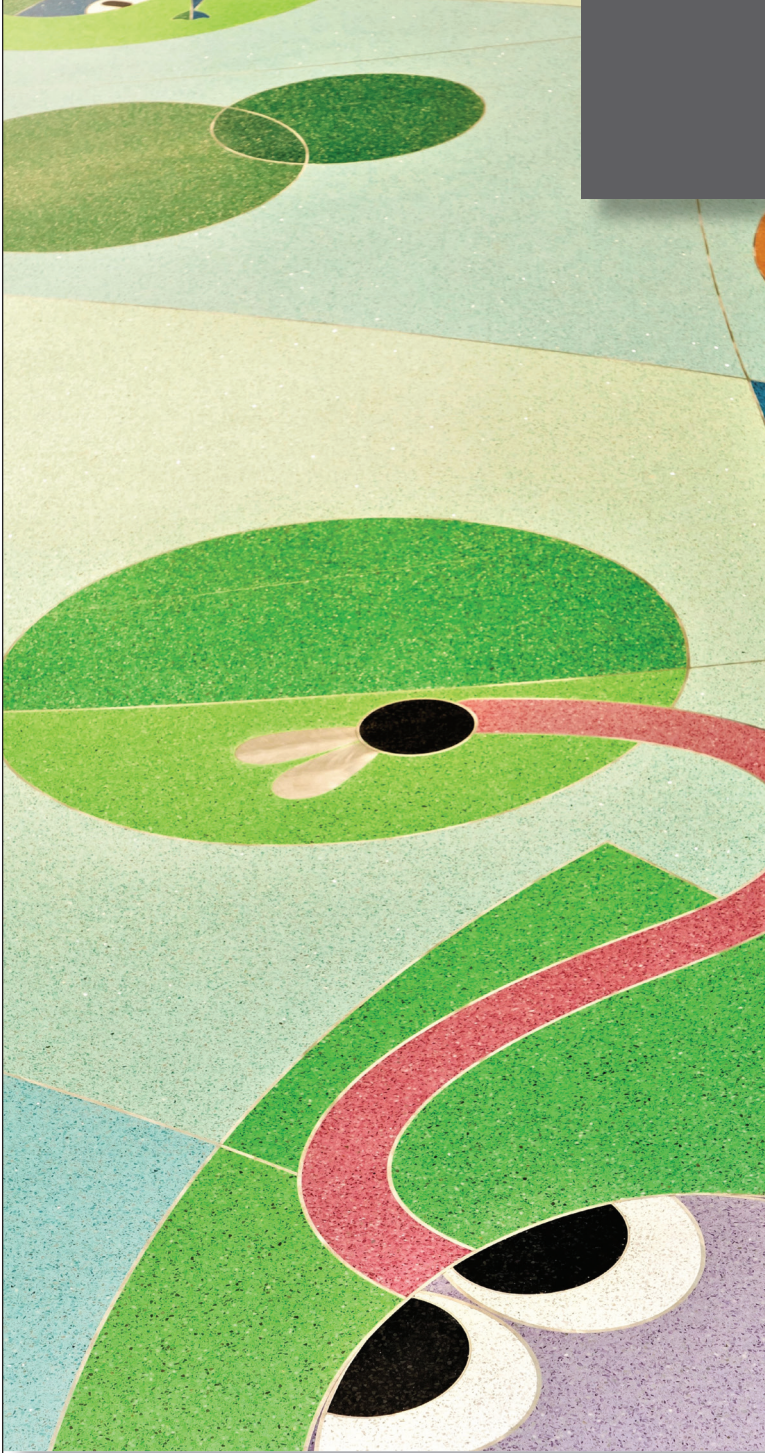

The sun and its planets, including Jupiter's spot and Saturn's rings, are found in this high-impact astronomy-themed floor of a new school with a 100-seat planetarium. Asteroids and stars are represented by glow-in-the-dark terrazzo, and orbit rings are represented by divider strips. Cast aluminum labels for the planets and a NASA satellite are also inset in the floor. The curving corridor that crosses the school features a sine-wave in the terrazzo. The glossy 18-color epoxy terrazzo installation also includes two flights of self-supporting terrazzo stairs.

FROGTOWN COMMUNITY CENTER ST. PAUL, MN



The floor is the focal point in this playful installation in 34 vibrant epoxy terrazzo colors. A trio of local artists collaborated on the design. Art mirrors function as the design in the hallway maps the lifecycle of a frog, from eggs to tadpoles to adults, to assist way-finding in the progression of rooms from toddlers to grade-schoolers to teens. The waterjet-cut strip design depicts overlapping ripples in the water in shades of blue. Terrazzo provides high visual impact with durability and low-maintenance to serve the community for many years to come.

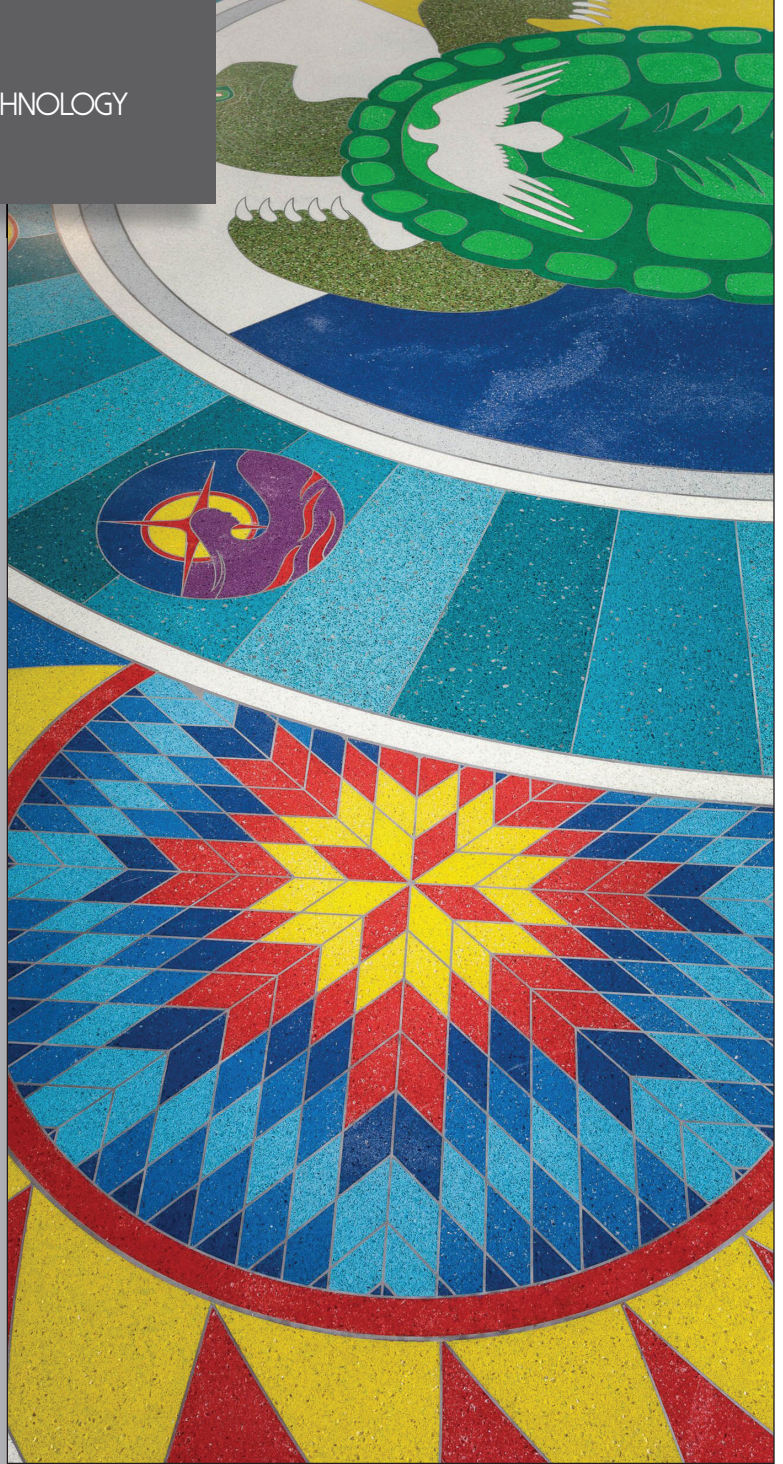
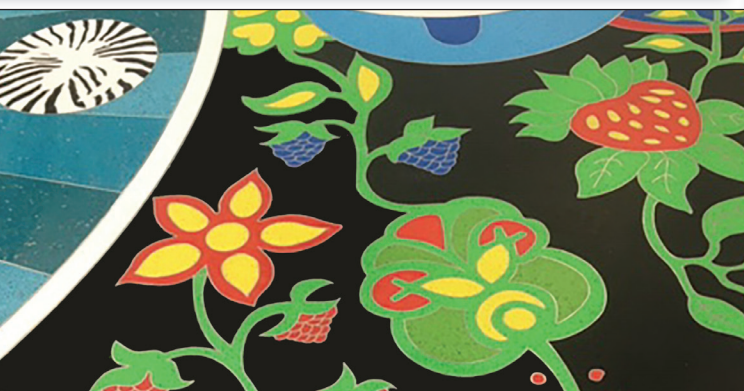

The raw materials in creating this striking work of art were epoxy terrazzo in 22 vibrant colors with white glass, clear glass, mirror, and marble chips and an intricate waterjet-cut aluminum divider strip pattern. This durable installation will last the life of the building. The local indigenous community was engaged in the development of this new facility for innovation, technology, and entrepreneurship. The terrazzo contractor worked closely with the artist, a member of the Neskantaga First Nation, producing numerous color samples to ensure that his vision was translated accurately into the floor.
