



Toolbox Talk: Terrco 2000 Floor Grinder

The 2000 floor grinder is a very heavy and powerful machine. The net weight of the 2000 is 800lb. The power configuration is either 230 volt or 430 volt. Always make sure the machine is well maintained; always disconnect power before working on machine and or changing stones. Never work on machine with power plugged in.

Before use of this machine, you must consider what personal protective equipment is necessary. This machine may produce loud noise, vibration, or dust.

Inspect machine before each use. Check power cords for cuts or any damage. Look for any loose parts. Never use damaged or defective machines. Remove from service immediately, if any of these issues are discovered.

Follow these safe work practices anytime you use this machine:

Disconnect power before moving or working on machine. Use both hands when operating machine. Use both hands when moving machine. Always maintain proper footing and balance. Never disable or remove guards. Keep bystanders at a safe distance. Make sure work area has plenty of light. Make sure that work area is free and clear of all obstacles and loose debris. Always make sure that counter weights are in their proper locations before using or transporting machine.
