

Toolbox Talk: Wet Saws

The wet saw is a common tool for the terrazzo trade.

Before use of this machine, always read the manufactures instructions, also consider what personal protective equipment is necessary. Does this machine produce loud noise, vibration, or dust.

PPE: Gloves, safety glasses, face shield

Inspect machine before each use. Check power cords for cuts or any damage. Look for any loose parts. Never use damaged or defective machines. Always have guard, handles on machine never remove. If machine is damaged remove from service immediately.
